If the fee dispute is for less than \$10,000, it is heard by one (1) arbitrator. If it is for \$10,000 or more, it is heard by three (3) arbitrators, one who shall be a non-lawyer. If both you and the client agree, you can have the dispute heard by one (1) arbitrator even if the dispute is for \$10,000 or more.

Unless both you and the client agree in writing to **BINDING ARBITRATION**, this arbitration is **NON-BINDING**. This means that if you or the client are not satisfied with the award, either of you has the right to ask for a new trial in a civil court **within 30 days from the date the award is mailed to you**. If neither of you ask for a new trial in 30 days, the award **automatically becomes final and binding**.

If you and the client both agree in writing to make the arbitration **BINDING**, a new trial **MAY NOT BE REQUESTED** and the award **will immediately become final and binding on both of you**.
